Henderson County, unbeaten Big Eight champ the past three years, placed seven players on the 1978 All-Conference team announced Saturday. Colonel coach Mojo Hollowell was named Coach of the Year for the third straight time last week.

Henderson, which was eliminated from the 4-A playoffs Friday night and ended the season with a 9-3 mark, landed guard Terry Sugg, tackle Rick Thompson and end Randy Trent on the offensive team. Tackle Jeff Combest, outside linebacker Tony Barron and deep back Greg Blemker made the defensive squad. Kicker Jeff Bowling, who was five-for-five on field goal attempts this season, made the team as place kicker.

The Colonels were out-represented on the team by Owensboro Catholic, which finished the year with a losing record, 5-6.

The Aces placed nine players on the All-Big Eight squad, including quarterback Chris Brown, who tied for the QB spot with Owensboro's Tony James.

Catholic's other representatives included end Mark Hyland, tackle Scott Murphy, guard P.J. Ebelhar and center Jerry Chapman on the offense. Tackle Steve Moorman, inside linebacker Nick Clements and outside linebacker Tony Brand made the defensive line-up. Catholic also had punter Fitz Hayden on the squad.

One of the biggest surprises of the balloting was that Union County did not have a single representative. Coach Dickie McDonald's 3-A Braves wound up in third place in the conference and a final 7-5 record.

Madisonville and Daviness County both had four All-Big Eight selections while Owensboro had three and Apollo two.

In the backfield, along with quarterbacks Brown and James, were Madisonville's Melvin Nicholson, Daviness' Keith Johnson and Owensboro Chuck Riley and Terrance Thompson.

The seven Big Eight coaches voted for the All-Conference team.
